

Kristin Moore. Dr. Moore has been with Child Trends since 1982, studying trends in child and family well-being, adolescent development, effective programs and practices, the determinants and consequences of adolescent parenthood, the effects of poverty and welfare on children, and positive development. Dr. Moore was the founding chair of the Effective Programs and Research Task Force for the National Campaign to Prevent Teen and Unplanned Pregnancy. From 1998 to 2003, she served as a member of the National Advisory Council of the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development. She is a founding Board member of the International Society for Child Indicators. Dr. Moore currently serves on advisory boards for the Edna McConnell Clark Foundation, Big Brothers Big Sisters, the Family Impact Seminar, the National Survey of Children's Health, Wings for Kids, the Committee for Children, and the International Society for Child Indicators. Dr. Moore was recently chosen as a Fellow by the National Council for Family Relations.
